

OVERVIEW

Reds Global is committed to sound environmental policies to afford protection to our natural and manmade environments. This policy sets out the responsibilities of Reds Global and its employees with the aim that together we can maintain a healthy environment.

This policy has been written to consider current EPA rules, guidance and legislation, and to meet the requirements of AS/NZS 14001: 2015 Environmental Management Systems.

OBJECTIVES

The overall objectives of the Reds Global's approach to our environment include:

- Ensure the use of chemicals in our Somersby workshop and yards are identified, controlled, suitably stored, and disposed of
- Ensure the natural bushland around our Somersby Corporate offices, workshop and yard is maintained to avoid fire and pollution, to protect our flora and fauna
- To minimise pollution and excessive use of power, water, and other natural products.

Reds Global will seek to achieve this by:

- Ensure, wherever possible, to eliminate chemicals with a high risk to the environment,
- To purchase, use and maintain chemicals which are identified as environmentally friendly, where possible,
- To monitor and maintain control over disposal of our waste, including reclaimed fluids,
- To monitor our natural environment surrounding the Somersby Corporate offices, workshop and yard through inspection and monitoring,
- Ensure our workers are aware of our environmental commitment through induction and general communication.

Manager and Supervisor Responsibilities

All managers and supervisors are responsible and accountable for the implementation of this policy.

Employee, Visitor and Subcontractor Responsibilities

- To be aware of the environmental policy and commitment of Reds Global through induction and general communication and to ask or seek information if unsure.

To follow workplace instructions and procedures in relation to environmental matters.
